DIRECTIONS

From Austin, travel west on TX-71 for 77.3 miles. Turn left onto TX-16 S/Ford St. After 10.1 miles turn right onto Co Rd 113. After 5.8 miles turn left onto Co Rd 113A. After 3.8 miles make a slight left onto Inks Ranch Rd.

From San Antonio, follow I-10 W for 46.4 miles. Take exit 523 to merge onto US-87 N toward Fredericksburg/San Angelo. After 21.5 miles turn left onto E Main St. After 0.3 miles turn right onto TX-16 N/N Llano St/N State Hwy 16. After 10.1 miles turn left onto Co Rd 113. After 5.8 miles turn left onto Co Rd 113A. After 3.8 miles make a slight left onto Inks Ranch Rd.

8-9:00 A.M. ARRIVAL
